

Sarkis Joseph Khoury, Ph.D.

Dr. Khoury is a professor of finance and international finance at the University of California-Riverside. He serves as the Executive Director of the International Programs at the A. Gary Anderson Graduate School of Business. He is also the Executive Director of the Foundation for Research in International Banking and Finance and Editor in Chief of its main publication: ADVANCES IN INTERNATIONAL BANKING AND FINANCE. Dr. Khoury is a Member of the Board of Directors of the Philadelphia Board of Trade, and served for several years as a weekly commentator on KWHY television (the first All Business Channel) until it was sold in 2000. Dr. Khoury owns his own consulting firm dealing with a wide range of valuation issues, especially those relating to forensic cases.

He has lectured all over the world on a wide range of financial/economic issues, and served as a consultant to corporations, to financial institutions, and to academic institutions.

Dr. Khoury has authored or edited twenty-three books and monographs dealing with corporate finance, valuation models (domestic and international), international banking and international finance, foreign exchange markets, and investment issues. He has published numerous articles, many appearing in leading journals in the United States and other countries, primarily Europe. The articles cover a wide range of financial and economic issues.

His latest research deals with systemic risk, banking and technology, new approaches to valuation and knowledge management.

Dr. Khoury earned his Ph.D. in International Finance from The Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania (1978).

Dr. Khoury has taught previously and for an extended period of time at the University of Notre Dame, Bucknell University, the University of British Columbia, USC, the Claremont Graduate School, the American University of Beirut, and the University of Gothenburg in Sweden. He has lectured in at least 15 other universities in various parts of the world, and has given numerous interviews to major publications in the world of business and politics.

Dr. Khoury was a candidate for the US Congress in the 1990's and lost by the slimmest of margins.
