David Savage has covered the U.S. Supreme Court in the Washington bureau of the Los Angeles Times since 1986. He also writes regularly on other legal topics, including the impeachment of President Clinton, the Florida recount that followed the 2000 Presidential election, and, more recently, the "war on terrorism." Before moving to Washington, he covered education and the University of California system for the paper in Los Angeles.

David Savage is the author of "Turning Right: the Making of the Rehnquist Supreme Court," published in 1992, which covered the efforts of the Reagan and first Bush administration to create a more conservative high court. He also writes a monthly column on the Supreme Court for the American Bar Assn. Journal and does regular legal analyses for National Public Radio.
