

### ***America in the Course of Human Events***

An edited selection of papers from the 2004 EAAS conference ('America in the Course of Human Events') which was held at Charles University, Prague, has just been published by VU University Press (Amsterdam). It inevitably includes just a small selection of those papers that were given. However, one of those chosen by the organisers was by Edward Ashbee from CBS's Center for the Study of the Americas. *The Bush Administration, the Republicans and Sexual Politics* considers the Bush's administration responses to the moral issues such as homosexuality that have often divided Americans.

For Edward Ashbee, the EAAS paper was a step towards a book-length study of administration policies. *The Bush Administration, Sex and the Moral Agenda* will be published this autumn by Manchester University Press (UK).
