Key to the table

Weights in brackets

Salary today €: An average of salaries three years after graduation. The figure is in Euros and is NOT used in the ranking.

Weighted salary € (20): The average 'salary today' with adjustment for salary variations between industry sectors (in Euros).

Value for money rank (5): The value for money criterion is a short-term indicator calculated using the salary earned by alumni three years after graduation and course costs. The length of the course is also taken into consideration.

Jobs rank (10): The career status of alumni three years after graduation. Progression is measured through level of seniority and the size of company in which they are employed.

Aims achieved % (5): The extent to which alumni fulfilled their goals or reasons for doing a Masters in Management. This is measured as a percentage of total returns for a school.

Placement success rank (5): The percentage of alumni that gained employment with the help of career advice. The data is presented as a rank.

Employment at three months % (5): The percentage of the most recent graduating class that had gained employment within three months. The figure in brackets is the percentage of the class on which the school was able to provide employment data.

Women faculty % (3): The percentage of female faculty.

Women students % (3): The percentage of female students.

Woman board % (1): Female members of the advisory board, as a percentage.

International faculty % (5): The percentage of faculty whose nationality differs from their country of employment.

International students % (5): The percentage of international students.

International board % (2): The percentage of the board whose nationality differs from that of the business school.

Faculty with doctorates % (6): The percentage of faculty with a doctoral degree.

International mobility rank (10): A rating system that measures the degree of international mobility based on the employment movements of alumni between graduation and today.

International course experience rank (10): Weighted average of three criteria that measure international exposure during the course.

Languages (5): Number of additional languages required on graduation from the masters programme.
