



EBSCO Databases

Persistent links to articles in EBSCO databases (Business Source Complete, Academic Search Elite and many others)

- Retrieve the article of your choice (cf. "Finding an article")
- Select "CBS Link" and choose database.
- When you see your article on the screen, select "Permalink" in the right hand side of the screen
