NOFOMA Conference Special Issue of *International Journal of Physical Distribution & Logistics Management*

The Nordic Logistics Research Network's NOFOMA annual conference has traditionally collaborated with IJPDLM on the publication of selected conference papers in an annual special issue of the journal. This year we would like to emphasize that the intent of the annual special issue is to encourage leading researchers to submit and present their best work (i.e., "journal ready" rather than "conference ready" papers) to the 26th NOFOMA conference at Copenhagen Business School 11-13 June 2014.

Authors submitting to the conference who also want their papers to be considered for publication in this prestigious special issue of IJPDLM must send a separate email to the NOFOMA Scientific Committee entitled "IJPDLM Special Issue" when uploading their paper in the NOFOMA conference system. Following this process, we anticipate that the Annual NOFOMA Conference Special Issue of IJPDLM will serve as an annual showcase for the very best research conducted by Nofoma member logistics and SCM researchers.
