sending the extended abstract (PDF) in an e-mail together with the submitter's name and affiliation to COPE2021@au.dk. The proposals will then be jointly reviewed by the Standing Scientific Committee and Guest Reviewers. Authors will be informed of their acceptance by December 4, 2020.

In case of acceptance, a full paper has to be provided by **February 19, 2021**, at the latest. Further information will be available on a homepage that will be available in August.
