CBS EXECUTIVE SCHOLARSHIP OF EXCELLENCE

AMOUNT:

Varied amounts are awarded based on profile and merit

ALLOCATION & CRITERIA:

Based on evaluation of at least three of the following:

- Excellent academic qualification and performance
- Impressive career progression
- Leadership potential
- Passion for sustainability
- International experience
- GMAT score of min. 690

ELIGIBILITY:

All candidates demonstrating outstanding academic achievements, and whose background, work experience and personal profile contribute to the diversity in the MBA class

DECISION:

Admissions Board



WALDEMAR SCHMIDT SCHOLARSHIP

AMOUNT:

One full scholarship available

ALLOCATION & CRITERIA:

Based on a separate scholarship interview with scholarship donor Mr. Waldemar Schmidt and the evaluation of the following criteria:

- GMAT score of 600 or above
- GRE score of 300 or above
- High emotional intelligence
- Good academic results
- Good career progression
- Demonstrated need for funding

ELIGIBILITY:

Priority is given to Brazilian candidates who are accepted to the Copenhagen MBA

APPLICATION:

Reach out the Admissions Manager after receiving your full acceptance to the Copenhagen MBA to schedule a date and time for the scholarship interview

DECISION:

Mr. Waldemar Schmidt together with Admissions Board
