# WALDEMAR SCHMIDT SCHOLARSHIP



The Waldemar Schmidt Scholarship is a unique opportunity for financial support towards studying an MBA at Copenhagen Business School. The scholarship originates from Waldemar Schmidt, a former CEO of the Danish conglomerate ISS and who has a strong affiliation with CBS through his adjunct professorship and as a long-time ambassador of the MBA program. Waldemar Schmidt has spent a considerable part of his career overseas and strongly believes in coupling Scandinavian leadership values with an international mindset in a business setting.

## SCHOLARSHIP:

100.000 DKK per recipient\*

To be eligible, students must be accepted into the Full-time MBA Program at Copenhagen Business School. Scholarship can only be used towards tuition.

## CRITERIA:

Students from Brazil will be given priority followed by Latin American and Asian students.

- GMAT score of 600 or above
- GRE score of 300 or above
- A person with high EQ
- Good academic results
- Good career progression
- Demonstrate need for funding

## HOW TO APPLY:

- Applicants should contact the Full-Time MBA Admissions Manager.
- Following which an interview will be conducted to evaluate scholarship prospects.

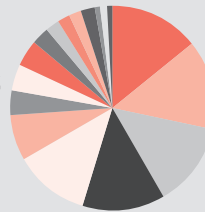
