The Waldemar Schmidt Scholarship is a unique opportunity for financial support towards studying an MBA at Copenhagen Business School. The scholarship originates from Waldemar Schmidt, a former CEO of the Danish conglomerate ISS, who has a strong affiliation with CBS through his adjunct professorship as a long-term ambassador of the MBA programme. Waldemar Schmidt has spent a considerable part of his career overseas and strongly believes in combining Scandinavian leadership values with an international mindset in a business setting.

SCHOLARSHIP:

100 000 DKK per recipient

To be eligible, you must have been accepted as a student of the Copenhagen MBA. Scholarships can only be used towards tuition.

CRITERIA:

Students from Brazil will be given priority followed by Latin American and Asian students.

- GMAT score of 600 or above
- GRE score of 300 or above
- High emotional intelligence
- Good academic results
- Good career progression
- Demonstrated need for funding
