Current Reform Efforts



Schools:

- Re-thinking core service from teaching to learning
- Transgressing institutional boundaries between the teaching and leisure activities, school and the local community

Social services for the disabled and elderly citizens

- Re-thinking core services from compensation and service to rehabilitation
- Involving the citizen and her network in collaborative welfare creation

Leading life? Distance as a problem



Each reform initiative reconceptualises welfare as a value emerging in local and co-creative processes

- How do central governmental agencies facilitate these kind of processes at a distance?
- How does distance become a acknowledge premise in the development of new managerial technologies?

The experience from central implementations efforts are not very positive

Two lines of technology applied in both fields

Result-Based Management:

Outcome-oriented objectives, programme theory, performance indicators, controlling – negotiated with local government

Network Management

Capacity building initiated by campaigns, networks, and mobilization of professionals – often developed across sectorial and hierarchical boundaries Send different symbolic messages

Strategies: Selection Separation Integration Transcendence
