SPECULATING ON CHAOS IN THE ERA OF FINANCIALISED POPULISM

The talk will address the recent explosion of political, economic and organisational discourses of chaos – a phenomenon that can be described in sociological terms as a 'radicalisation of uncertainty'. It will discuss the serious implications of a growing global impatience with the future promises of neoliberalism in the aftermath of the 2008 crisis. It will be argued, specifically, that these developments signal a shift from the risk-taking, entrepreneurial agent of the post Bretton-Woods era, to a politically disoriented, speculative subject, who endorses rather than averts the future's radical uncertainty. This leads to a dramatic re-calibration of the tension between economy and polity, with new political re-alignments and conflicts being formed around speculative wagers on political instability and volatility. The talk will propose analysing these transformations through the speculative imagination, a concept which enables us to explain the mounting convergence between 'markets' and 'publics' in the financialised era. It will conclude with some reflections on the radical possibilities for progressive counter-speculation deployed by contemporary social movements to resist and challenge financialisation.
